



## **THANK YOU FOR YOUR INTEREST IN VOLUNTEERING**

For box office volunteers, an email is sent out (from GT Volunteer Management) as needed--about a month before each show opening--and spots are filled on a first come first served basis. Volunteering would involve coming an hour before the show starts and handing out or selling tickets and includes a comp ticket to see the show, if you want to stay. Dress is like casual Friday at an office - jeans are okay, but no ripped jeans or graphic t-shirts. Minimum age for Box Office volunteers is 16 years old. If you are interested in ushering, please contact our usher captain, Mark Blonstein at [nomosno14@bellsouth.net](mailto:nomosno14@bellsouth.net). He requires a training session at the theatre before you usher and will also allow you to "shadow" before actually ushering, if you're more comfortable with that. Minimum age for usher volunteers is 16 years old.

We prefer that all backstage volunteers first participate in a set strike (approximately 15 minutes after the performance ends on the Sunday a show closes). Craig will then discuss backstage opportunities with you. Age requirements for backstage work are at the discretion of the Technical Director, but opportunities are typically available for individuals ages 16 and up.
